You can find information in a number of places in Kamloops:

- School library

- Kamloops Museum and Archives
- SD#73 Archives
- Kamloops Family History Society
- The City of Kamloops
- A large variety of cultural societies
- Kamloops Daily News Archives

Excellent historical research uses Primary Sources to find important information. Primary Sources include the following:

- Personal interviews
- Diaries and journals
- Newspapers and magazine reports
- Media reports
- First hand narratives
- Photographs, drawings, etc.
- Minutes of meetings

Researchers also use Secondary Sources to help them interpret information and put the information in context. Secondary Sources include the following:

- Encyclopedias
- Textbooks
- History texts
- Newspaper and magazines – editorials and commentaries
- Artistic interpretations – dramas and play
