

2. How can I participate in a Heritage Fair?

Most students enter the Heritage Fair program through their classroom teacher. Generally, the fair is part of a teacher's planning for the year. The Heritage Fair program allows a teacher to cover many aspects of the curriculum by using a project approach to learning.

In some cases, a school may host a local Heritage Fair as part of their yearly plans. This allows a great number of students to enter the fair program through the school and be selected to attend the Regional Heritage Fair.

Students whose teacher or school are not hosting a heritage fair; or who are not attending a public school; or who are attending the Virtual School, or are taking correspondence or home schooling, may register individually.
